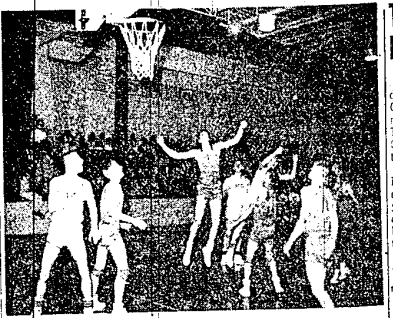

Falcons Score Easy Victory Over Waterford Five, 66-49

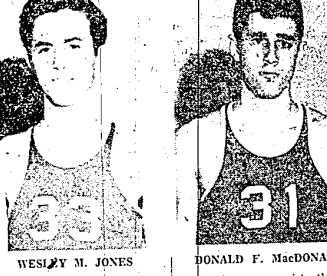
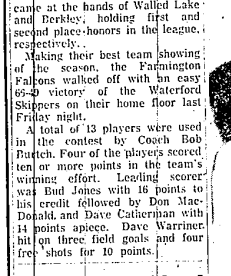
