## Wing Being Added To North Church With Funds Contributed By Trustee

A gift of \$260,000 is being provided to the North Congregational Church by Mr. Thomas G. Long, one of its distinguished members, in memory of his wife, Mabel Ann, who passed away about a year ago. With the money, a wing to the newly constructed North Congregational Church, located at North-Western Highway and Laker Road, which moved a year ago from its former home at Woodward and Blaine, is now under construction. The present edifice is of modern architecture and is built on the Church property of 33 acres. The Mabel Ann Long wing, being built with the gift of money, is about midway in its construction. It will add a Fellowship Hall which will seat 350 people, including a stage, an office for the Superintendent of the Church School and children's classrooms, and ample kitchen facilities and a store-room. It is expected to be completed late this spring, which will make the overall investment of the church well over a million dollars. The architects are O'Dell, Hewlett, and Luckenbach, of Birmingham. A two-story wing will be added later at a cost of roughly \$200,000 which will house the expanding Junior and Senior high school educational department. Reverend Ralph H. Read is the minister of North Church. Two hundred fifty new members have been received during his five years ministry. This makes a total membership of 853 at the new location. Mr. and Mrs. Long have been devoted members of North Church since 1919. Mrs. Long was a member of the Women's Association. Mr. Long has, for many years, been a Trustee of the church and at the present time is the moderator of North Church. Through the years Mr. Long has been active in the Detroit Congregational Association and for the year 1955-56 was moderator of the association.
