CHAPTER XVII

SUBMISSION AND ELECTION

Section 1. This charter shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Wood Creek Farms for their approval or rejection at an election to be held on Monday, the 3rd day of June, 1957, at which election the several elective 3rd lage officers provided for in this charter shall also be elected.

Section 2. Prior to the submission of this charter, it shall be published once in a newspaper published in the County of Oakland and circulated in the Village of Wood Creek Farms not less than two weeks or more than four weeks preceding said election, together with a notice of said election, which notice shall state that at said election the question of adopting said proposed charter will be voted on and the elective officers provided for therein will be elected and shall also state the location of the polling place for such election and other matters required by law. Notice of said election shall also be posted in at least ten (10) public places within the Village not less than two weeks prior to said election.
