Youth Choirs To Give Concert

The multiple youth choirs of the Southfield Community Church, 211-22 Indian Street (near Inkster and 18th Mile) will present a concert on Sunday evening, May 26, at 7 p.m., under the direction of Howard Redman, Minister of Youth and Music.

This will be a climax of the year's work by the youth in providing for the music of the church. The youth program of the church is centered around five departmentally graded choirs which meet separately for rehearsal and devotional and social activities but sing as a combined group on Sunday. Approximately one hundred youth are found singing in the church service each week.

The devotional and social activities of the groups are carried on by leaders of the church working with Mr. Redman and the Pastor, Raymond Bayne. The Joy Club for the Primary Department (1st, 2nd, and 3rd graders) meets Saturday morning. Pioneers for the Juniors meet Friday evening as does the Crusaders for the Junior High. The Ambassadors for high schoolers meet on Thursday. The college group meets every other Sunday evening after the service.

These programs are augmented by an annual vacation Bible school and summer camping program at Camp Michawana. Sixty young people attended the camp last year.
