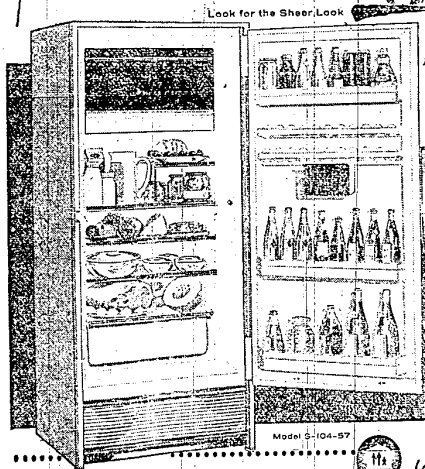

Obituary

Earl Murrell

Mr. Earl Murrell, 21902 Albion, passed away suddenly from a heart condition, May 19, at his residence.

He was born in Desloge, Missouri, April 20, 1887, the son of Herbert and Stella (Jones) Murrell and was united in marriage to Mabel Spilde, January 28, 1931. He had resided in Farmington 19 years and was employed as a hotel clerk.

He leaves his wife, Mabel; one daughter, Mrs. Gertrude Moylan of Allen Park; his mother, Mrs. Stella Murrell of Detroit; one sister, Mrs. Bessie Beck of Detroit, and five grandchildren. A son, Leo, was killed in World War II while serving in the United States Army.

Funeral services were held from the Spencer J. Heeney Funeral Home at 11:00 a.m. Wednesday, with Reverend Russell Sorsay of the Farmington Methodist Church officiating.

Interment was in Grand Lawn Cemetery, Detroit.

Several points in the Farmington area will be visited during the annual garden tour of the Detroit Garden Center to be held June 22 and 23.

Included on the agenda of the tour will be a visit to the grounds of Mr. and Mrs. Hugh Dean at 27800 Twelve Mile Road, a country estate which includes a formal garden, beautiful lake, and extensive area of lawn and feed crop acreage. The garden of Mr. and Mrs. Dan Guy at 33503 Shiawassee offers a view of old fashioned planting offering a distinctive setting for an interesting house well over 100 years old.

The home of Mr. and Mrs. James Henry at 24560 Orchard Lake Road to be visited gives an excellent example of a do-it-yourself landscape project that has followed a professional master plan. Flower arrangements are included throughout the house. At the home of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Crooks at 4941 Twelve Mile Road, grounds adjacent to a stone house built in 1914 with a walled garden and antique shop recreates the past. Also to be visited will be the grounds of Mr. and Mrs. William Taylor at 25280 Westmoreland where a suburban setting for modern outdoor living in a ranch house style can be viewed. The final leg of the area tour will be Knox House at Farmington Road and 11 Mile. This is a fine, traditional house recently purchased by the Presbyterian Church and the site where the Farmington Junior Garden Club will hold its 10th anniversary flower show. Punch will be served here by the Farmington Garden Club as a feature of its 23th anniversary celebration.

Tickets are now available for the tour and may be purchased locally from Catherine Williams at 31789 Stannan Circle Drive, GR 4-7439. The deadline for purchasing advance tickets will be June 3. Tickets will be sold during the tour but will be more costly, Mrs. Williams pointed out.
