FARMINGTON PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT OF OAKLAND AND WAYNE COUNTIES, MICHIGAN BUILDING AND SITE BONDS SERIES 1

Sealed bids for the purchase of Building and Site Bonds, Series 1, of the Farmington Public School District, Oakland and Wayne Counties, Michigan, of the amount of \$2,000,000, will be received by the undersigned, at the office of the Board of Education, 15000 Thomas Street, Farmington, Michigan, until 8:00 o'clock P.M., Eastern Standard Time, on Monday, the 22nd day of July, 1957, at which time and place said bids will be publicly opened and read.

The bonds to be sold are \$1000 bonds, will be coupon bonds in the denomination of \$1,000 each, will be numbered consecutively in the first order of their maturities from 1 to 2,000, both inclusive, and will bear interest from their date of issue at the rate of 4 1/2% per annum, payable on December 1, 1957, and thereafter semi-annually on June 1 and December 1. Each bid shall state the annual interest rate or rates proposed, which is submitted, expressed in multiples of 1/8 of 1%. The interest rate for each coupon period on any one bond shall be at one rate only. Accrued interest to date of delivery of such bonds must be paid by the purchaser at the time of delivery.

Said bonds will mature serially on the first day of June in each year as follows: \$100,000 in each of the years 1960 through 1962; \$200,000 in each of the years 1963 through 1965; \$300,000 in each of the years 1966 through 1968; \$400,000 in each of the years 1969 through 1971; \$500,000 in each of the years 1972 through 1974; \$600,000 in each of the years 1975 through 1977; \$700,000 in each of the years 1978 through 1980; \$800,000 in each of the years 1981 and 1982; and \$1,000,000 in the year 1983. Bonds maturing in the years 1968 through 1983, are subject to redemption by the school district prior to maturity, in inverse numerical order, on any one or more interest payment dates, on the basis of the lowest rate of interest then accrued interest plus a premium on each bond in accordance with the following schedule:

\$25 if called to be redeemed on or after June 1, 1967, but prior to June 1, 1970;
\$20 if called to be redeemed on or after June 1, 1970, but prior to June 1, 1973;
\$15 if called to be redeemed on or after June 1, 1973, but prior to June 1, 1976;
\$10 if called to be redeemed on or after June 1, 1976, but prior to June 1, 1979;
\$5 if called to be redeemed on or after June 1, 1979.

Notice of redemption shall be published at least 30 days prior to the date fixed for redemption, at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Detroit, Michigan, which carries as part of its regular circulation the sale of municipal bonds. The remaining bonds will not be subject to redemption prior to maturity. The interest will be payable at such bank or trust company as shall be designated by the original purchaser of the bonds.

The bonds are to be a part of a total authorized issue of \$4,000,000, of which the proceeds of the sale of the bonds are to be used for the cost of erecting and furnishing new elementary school buildings, and for the cost of erecting and furnishing additional school sites in said school district, and will be the general obligations of the school district. The bonds are not required by law to levy upon all the taxable property therein such ad valorem taxes as may be necessary to pay said bonds and the interest thereon, without limitation of amount.

For the purpose of awarding the bonds, the interest cost of each bid will be computed by determining the rate or rates specified therein, the total dollar value of all interest on the bonds of that bid, and the total dollar value of the bonds of that bid, and the bidder whose bid produces the lowest interest cost on the bonds will be awarded the bonds. No proposal for the purchase of less than all of the bonds or at a price less than their par value will be considered.

A certified or cashier's check in the amount of \$40,000 drawn upon an incorporated bank or trust company and payable to the order of the Treasurer of the school district must accompany each bid as a guarantee of good faith on the part of the bidder, to be forfeited as liquidated damages if such bid is accepted and the bidder fails to take up any of the bonds. No interest will be allowed on the good faith checks and checks of the unsuccessful bidders will be promptly returned to their respective representatives or by registered mail.

Bids shall be conditioned upon the unqualified opinion of Berry, Stevens & Moorman, attorneys, Detroit, Michigan, approving the legality of the bonds. The cost of said legal opinion and of the printing of the bonds will be paid by the school district. Bonds will be delivered at Detroit, Michigan. The right is reserved to reject any or all bids.

Envelopes containing the bids should be plainly marked "Proposal for Bonds."
