Ever notice that the jobs that look the easiest often turn out to be harder to do properly than the jobs that really look hard?

Well, I've got a theory about that. I think that what happens is that some things look SO easy that we assume there is nothing we have to learn before we try them. And on the other hand, most of us never tackle a tough-looking job without first taking the trouble to learn all we can about how it should be done.

Some people, for instance, don't even observe the most elementary rules, such as making sure the surface they're painting is clean and dry. Many neglect to clean the paint brush' or roller after each painting session. Clean with turpentine if it's oll base paint; water and detergent if it's rubber base paint.)
