Mobile Congressional "Office" To Visit Farmington Soon

A traveling Congressional "office" bringing the Federal Government closer to Oakland County residents this fall.

Congressman William S. Broomfield, (R-Oakland County) closed this week that a house trailer, or equipped as a mobile office will tour all cities, villages and townships in the Eighteenth District, starting September 18.

Broomfield said regular office hours will be maintained in the swing of the 40-foot long trailer through the county. Day-long stops will be made in most of the larger communities.

The touring office, the first of its kind in Oakland County, is an effort to "clear away the red tape" which residents often find in dealing with far-away Washington agencies of the Federal Government.

All are welcome to visit the trailer, when it visits their community, said Broomfield. "I will be glad to do what I can to solve problems dealing with the Federal Government."

"The trailer will allow me to talk over problems personally with my constituents," said Broomfield. "Many of these problems can be cleared up almost immediately during the 'off season' when the press of Congressional business is not so great."

Supplies of government bulletins and other literature of general interest will be on hand in the trailer for those Oakland County residents who desire it.

A schedule for the county Congressional tour will be announced in the near future, said Broomfield.

Broomfield conceived the idea for the trailer because of the difficulty the average citizen has in dealing with the Federal Government.

"Quite often, a Federal problem means either an expensive trip to Washington or a long series of letters which take a lot of time," he said.

"By use of the trailer, I hope to provide Oakland County residents with a direct link to agencies and their Federal Government, Broomfield concluded.

Name Assistant Mgrs. At Kresge's

Traffic Death Toll Down 179 Through Month Of August

Michigan State Police disclosed this week that the traffic death toll for the month of August was 33 under the number killed on state highways during the same month last year.

The figure brought up to 179 the total reduction in traffic deaths in the state for the first eight months of this year compared with a year ago. The reduction figure is subject to some readjustment with the receipt of delayed reports but, as it stands now, this reduction is five more than the minimum goal of 174 which had been set for the year.

The goal is a 10 per cent reduction under the 1,747 who lost their lives last year.

There were 126 deaths in August compared with 159 in August of 1956 for the eight months period now total 932 as against 1,131 for the same period of 1956.

"We are highly encouraged by the improved driving record and we want to compliment the drivers," said Commissioner Joseph A. Childs. "But without detracting from what they have accomplished thus far, it should be pointed out that beginning with this month we are entering upon the worst four months of the year. If there's any relaxation in efforts or in strong enforcement we can lose our gains, but I might say we are very optimistic about the outlook."
