#### Magnolia Co. Gets Contract

The contract for work needed in the older part of Gill Road Monday night approved two new traffic control orders restricting parking on portions of Slocum and Warner Streets and on Shiawassee Road between Farmington Road and Lakeway.

It was pointed out that traffic conditions at the intersection of Slocum and Warner had been aggravated through the improper actions of motorists in using the drive-up type mail box in front of the post office and that the no parking restrictions recommended should correct this problem.

No parking at any time is called for on the south side of Slocum from Farmington Road to Mayfield and no parking on Warner St. south from Slocum 300 feet between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

#### Traffic Restrictions Set by City

The post office department will also be asked to relocate its drive-up mail box in the parking lot area to the rear of the post office.

On Shiawassee Road there will be no parking allowed at any time on the north side of the street 250 feet west of Farmington Road to 250 feet east of Power Road. Only one hour parking will be allowed from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on the north side of Shiawassee Road between Farmington Road and Prospect to Lakeway in front of the high school and no parking from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. on the south side of Shiawassee between Prospect and Lakeway.

Parking will also be banned on the south side of Shiawassee from a point 250 feet west of Farmington Road to Power Road.
