School Workshop Bell Rings For Teachers In Farmington

The school bell rang for Farmington's elementary teachers last week. Some 300 classroom teachers spent two afternoons adding to their understanding and techniques of teaching art, music and physical education to children in kindergarten through sixth grade. Each day, their students were released from school early.

To keep the workshop sessions to a manageable size, teachers who planned the in-service training used a revolving session. On Wednesday, Jan. 27, upper elementary teachers assembled at Cloverdale School to consider the impact of physical education on the elementary school child. Simultaneously, lower elementary teachers were at William Grace School to hear a symposium on the fine arts. Thursday afternoon, Jan. 28, each group moved to the other subject area.

PRINCIPAL SPEAKER at the physical education workshop was Dr. Richard C. Havel, Divisional director of health and physical education at Wayne State University.

Michigan State University educators led the fine arts sessions—Charles McDermid and Martha White, music; and Malen Nemoto, art.

Dr. Havel, a newcomer to Detroit, in an interview commended the Farmington Public Schools for the facilities and interest they bestow on the physical education and fine arts curriculum.

"Surprisingly, the two fields have much in common," he said. "They have a universal appeal because the understanding and meaning derived from both are achieved independently of language. The obstacle of communication does not have to exist. In physical education and fine arts, individual expression is at the heart of what we have to do."

The opportunities for such expression carry beyond school boundaries, Havel emphasized. "The opportunities for personal growth are varied with the content learned. They serve as a recreational pursuit, both in the present and for the future."
