Missionary's Widow to Talk At 1st Baptist
Three months ago on November 24, Michigan-born Mrs. Helen W. Harcarik, a missionary to Congo, became a missionary widow. Her Canadian missionary husband was shot down by the rebels in Stanleyville.
There was scarcely, not even on the fact of her fifty-one year old woman as she and her six sons arrived in the States on December 21. Tears were shed, at that time, as they were peaceful, not rebellious. They want the children to know it was a special privilege, not a catastrophe, said their courageous mother. "I am glad that the Lord chose Hector for his purpose."

AT THE FIRST Baptist Church of Farmington on Sunday, March 7, Mrs. Helen W. Harcarik will be speaking at both services; the 10 o'clock morning worship and 7 p.m. evening service. She will tell in detail of the cold attack at which Mission home where her husband became a martyr for the cause of Christ, and where her two oldest sons, Kenneth, sixteen, and Paul, sixteen, were wounded. Her six sons age eleven through seventeen will accompany her to First Baptist of Farmington, where the Reverend Walter Ballagh is the pastor.

THE REVEREND Hector McMillan and his wife, Ione, have given twenty-three years of missionary service in the Congo, working under the Unweakened Foreign Mission and in the Board of Christian Workers. Missionaries and six children were slain during the November onslaught of the rebels in Stanleyville.
In light of the international experiences of Mrs. McMillan's, it may be that many in the community may be interested in attending the services. A warm and cordial invitation to come is extended to all who may wish to hear her.
