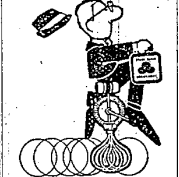

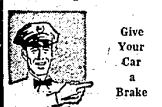
MOTION by Duke, supported by Oppenhausser, to approve transfer of said Class C. Liquor License-1964-at 27712 Eight

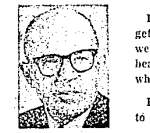

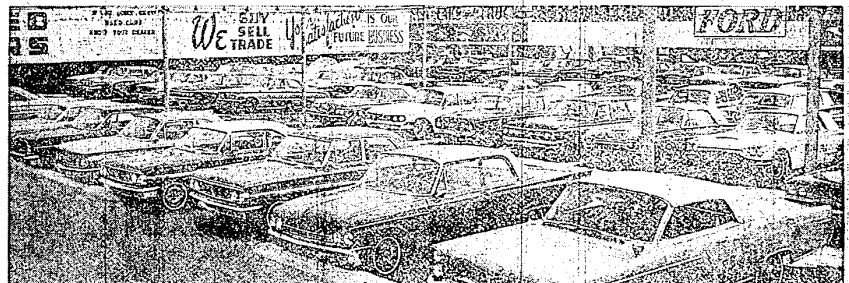
