## B. of C. Plans Two Meetings

Two meetings are planned for the latter part of this month for members of the Farmington Board of Commerce. Official action setting the dates for these two meetings will be taken at the board of directors' meeting on Thursday morning of last week.

The first meeting will be for retailers only and has been scheduled for 8 o'clock in the morning Thursday, March 24, in the dining room at Himmelspach's Restaurant. The meeting will be open to all retailers in the city of Farmington. The purpose of this meeting will be to attempt to determine how retailers feel the Board of Commerce can serve them better.

The second meeting will be a general membership meeting on Tuesday evening, March 30, with the program to be on accounting, methods and procedures and on various tax laws and regulations.

## Farmington Township Board Discusses Buying Fire Truck

Detailed discussion was conducted at the regular Farmington Township Board meeting Monday night on specifications and the various features of the proposed new fire truck to be bought by the township.

A John Bean truck, costing approximately \$24,000, has been recommended. A following of investigation by the township's four fire chiefs, Chief George Hume along with Chief Paul Button were present at the meeting.

It was pointed out by Hume and Supervisor Curt Hall that the fire department was attempting to standardize on John Bean equipment since this truck is manufactured in Lansing and there are no problems in getting parts and maintenance service when needed.

NO OFFICIAL action authorizing the purchase of the truck proposed was given. It was left in the hands of a committee made up of board members Earl Oppenheimer, Art Bassett and Floyd Cairns to work with the fire chiefs to complete details and report to the board with an official recommendation.

The new truck will replace the old 1946 truck now at Station No. 1 at the Star Cutter Co. plant but it was indicated that the old truck would not be traded in but would be kept as a reserve truck at this station.

The new truck has a 5 to 6 man enclosed cab and ladders reaching 35 feet high. Question

## Murder Trial Opens Tuesday

Wells S. Herrington of Farmington went on trial in Oakland County Circuit Court Tuesday on first degree murder charges for the fatal shooting of a Birmingham dentist in his Farmington West apartment last fall.

Judge George A. Dondoro began hearing testimony Tuesday afternoon following the selection of 13 jurors in the morning session. Oakland County Assistant Prosecutor James Roberts was still presenting his case at press time Wednesday.
