Jaycees Plan Bike Rodeo

There may not be wild horses, but it is hoped that there will be lots of bikes. The Farmington Junior Chamber of Commerce with the cooperation of the Police Department and the school authorities will have its annual Bike Rodeo Saturday, May 22, in the Farmington Junior High School parking lot.

As in the past years, the rodeo will be open to all Farmington area youngsters, it was announced by Fred Simon, Chairman of the event.

THE RODEO WILL feature a free bike safety inspection, marking bikes with reflector tape, a lecture by police officers, a station where bike licenses may be obtained and finally the rodeo course itself. The course will challenge the participants maneuverability and knowledge of safe bike practices.

It is planned that youngsters will compete by age groups and the judging of the events will be handled by the local police and Jaycees. Prizes will be awarded to the various youngsters upon winning the riding skill competition. The starting times for each age group will appear in next week's edition of the Farmington Enterprise—so be on the lookout. In addition, announcements will be distributed to all schools in the Farmington area.

The program, itself, is aimed at the continuing desire to improve bike safety as well as personal safety. It will be a good opportunity for the youngsters of the community to get their bikes checked.
