## Fluoride Tooth Treatment Program Still Expanding

Another successful year for the topical fluoride treatment program in the Farmington schools has just been completed.

The program was started four years ago as a protective measure against tooth decay. Kindergartners, 2nd, 5th and 8th graders have, during these past four years, received applications of 2 percent sodium fluoride solution directly to their teeth.

This process, dental health authorities claim, reduces tooth decay up to 40 percent.

The Farmington Area PTA Council sponsors the program with the cooperation of Michigan State and Oakland County Health Departments under the supervision of Dr. James Renell.

Serving on the fluoride committee since the beginning have been Dr. Renell, a re-a supervisor; Nicholas A.B.D., principal of William Grace School; and Mrs. Donald Babcock as treasurer.
