WINS TOP HONORS AT MIL SCHOOL Jon Elson, son of Dr. and Mrs. E. Elson, of 28427 West Nile Road, is one of only 37 cadets at Kemper Military School, Booneville, Missouri, designated to two of the school's honor societies in a special ceremony, conducted by Maj. Gen. J.P. Cleland, president.

Elson was designated to the Athletic Honor Society by Col. J.G. Kralovic, director of athletics, for outstanding performance on the Kemper high school football team this fall, and to the Scholar Honor Society by Col. F.J. Traffic Violators A large percentage of the country's motorists have difficulty in applying traffic laws and police regulations to their own personal conduct. This was revealed in a recent country-wide survey by a leading insurance company. Seventy-five per cent of the drivers questioned felt that generally, highway police are too easy on violators; while 88 per cent believed that the courts let violators off too easy. Yet 40 per cent of these drivers nevertheless stated that they committed violations which could land them in traffic court.
