(Continued from Page 2B) shows that one half of the teachers who started last year will have left teaching by 1962.

Some of these are girls who marry; others leave for better paying work.

A logical place for an ambitious teacher to move is into school administration. Consequently, there is a steady flow of good teachers into the ranks of principal and superintendent offices.

Bartlett favors the idea that school administrators have teaching experience, but he is unhappy that "good teachers must leave teaching for administration if he is to receive higher salaries within the framework of the educational system.

To the young person considering teaching as a profession there are two things to think about. Teaching is gradually gaining headway and more and more it is a profession where few teachers have been replaced by machines.

MICHIGAN WEEK preparations are continuing along as innumerable people on state and local committees all over the state devise plans to promote advantages of this state between May 4 and 10. A double barrel theme has been adopted this year: Education and Water Resources.
