Opposed to Two-Way Stop for School Buses - Dear Sir: There is an effort being made by certain groups to enact a two-way stop law in Michigan for traffic approaching a school bus. We think there is enough of a mess now in the traffic situation, without forcing it to stop in both directions. A school bus stop. Neither do we feel that it would afford greater safety for the children, to have the flow of traffic unduly restricted.

As it is now, traffic following a school bus is supposed to stop, then proceed with caution, when the bus stops to unload or load children. Traffic going the opposite way does not have to stop at all. Some motorists think they have to stop, and that causes problems.

Now, when only part of the school bus is stopped, the following and the line-up blocked a side road. Coming down the side road was a car carrying a sick child to the hospital, but it did not get onto the main road for awhile due to the traffic stoppage.

This foolish stopping has been known to block ambulances, fire engines, and police cars. Would not a law requiring every car to stop in both directions, greatly multiply the above situations? Of course not.

What about the children who have to cross the road after leaving the bus? At the present time they are required to cross in front of the bus. If the car is stopped, the bus driver gives the 'no signal.' It is 'no safer method.'

If Michigan adopted the two-way stop there would be more than just the traffic situation mentioned in the above paragraphs. It would be difficult to ascertain whether the oncoming would stop or not. Also, as mentioned in the above paragraphs, if we had more maniacs trying to pass on the shoulder so they can first out when the car starts to move. We remember one case where a car passed a school bus on the right hand side and nearly moved down half a mile before stopping.

For the sake of the children, and to keep traffic from piling up, ask your representatives to vote NO on the proposed bill. There are no STOP signs or red flashers on the front of school buses in Michigan. Let's keep it that way.

FOR GREATER SAFETY Editor's Note: The writer may not be aware that the two-way stop law is in effect in 46 other states, and that apparently it has worked for traffic safety because none of the states have seen fit to repeal the law.
