The Annual Spring Conference of District 7 (Oakland County) is presenting workshops for every phase of PTA.

Recognizing that few local PTA units could afford to send a delegate or more delegates to the State Convention in Muskegon, this conference, as a substitute, makes it possible for all of the 55,000 members here, to gain a wide knowledge of PTA in a single night, without involving great distance, overnight lodging or meal reservations. It is designed to widen the scope of every member to a realization that the Michigan Congress of Parents and Teachers can gain many advantages for children and their schools.

Three new workshops have been added this year: The Father Vice-President; Teachers Role in PTA; and High School PTA and PTA. Since most fathers, teachers, and students cannot take time off for daytime meetings the committee has made the very best time to present these specialized fields.

If everyone of the 232 local PTA units and the 15 councils send 18 delegates, their history and procedure books, the sharing of ideas will insure a very successful meeting, officials for the District meeting commented.

The workshops are as follows: Presidents and Vice Presidents; Father Vice-Presidents; Teachers Role in PTA; Council Presidents and Council Delegates; Program Secretaries; Treasurers, Budget, Ways and Means; High School PTA and PTA; Legislation; Publicity; Hospitality; Membership, Social Farmington Junior High School.

The first meeting of the Northwest Suburban Detroit Western Michigan University Club will be held at 8:00 p.m. Saturday evening, April 12, in the basement of the Farmington Savings and Loan Association at 31500 W. Ten - Mile Road.
