tle League last year to walk off with the batting champ trophy. Allen took top batting honors in the Babe Ruth League with a .419 average for the season. Not available when the picture was taken was Harvey Chapman, pitching champ in the Babe Ruth League with a record of five wins and one loss.

Set Rules Govern Program

Organizational rules governing the Baseball for Boys program are clearly spelled out in the constitution. Generally they provide as follows:

NUMBER OF TEAMS

(a) The number of uniformed Major League teams in both the Little League and Babe Ruth organizations shall be firmly set. They shall not be changed except as a duly constituted constitutional amendment. The number of teams in Minor or Farm League may be re-

vised as conditions demand at the discretion of Management Personnel.

SCHEDULE FOR GAMES

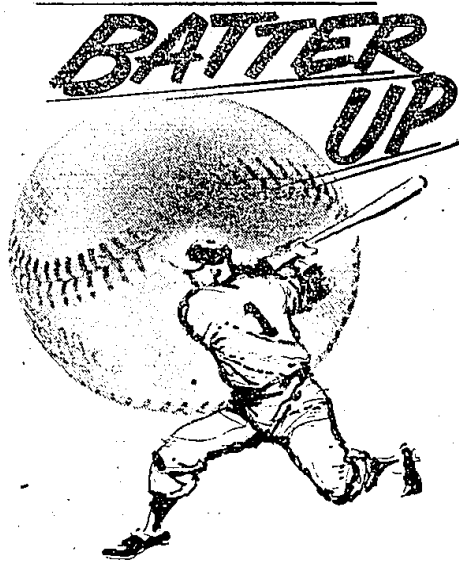
(b) Game schedules for all teams shall be the responsibility of the respective vice presidents or farm league directors. Care shall be taken to live up to the minimum game requirements of Little League or Babe Ruth League. Consideration shall be given to logical calendar timing to serve community and organization.

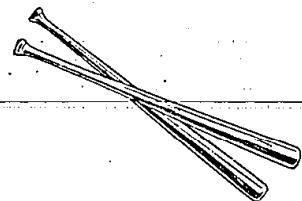
Tentative Schedule of Program Events

Annual events during the Baseball for Boys program and the approximate dates of each are stipulated in the constitution as follows:

- 1. Open Election Meeting to be held in November or December.
- 2. Spring Rally Meeting for Little League — approximately April 1st.
- 3. Little League Registration — approximately April 12th.
- 4. Start of Spring Practice for Little League — approximately April 15th.
- 5. Registration and Start of Spring Practice for Babe Ruth League — approximately May 1st.
- 6. Major Little League Players Draft — approx. May 15th.
- 7. Little League Opening Game and Ceremonies — approximately June 1st.
- 8. Babe Ruth League Players Draft — approx. June 15th.
- 9. Babe Ruth Opening Game and Ceremonies — approximately June 25th.
- 10. Farmington Baseball for Boys Sale of Decals — approximately June 25th.
- 11. Little League Tag Day — approximately 1st week in July.
- 12. Little League Farm League and 8 Yr. Old Picnic — approximately July 26th.
- 13. Victory Banquet — approximately September 20th.
