(All of Precinct No. 2 and Precinct No. 5 and Parts of Precinct No. 1, Precinct No. 6 and Precinct No. 8)

That the form and sufficiency of the petition heretofore filed on May 19, 1958, praying for the submission of the question of incorporation of the City to be known as "Clarencville" to consist of the territory described in said petition, complies with the provisions of the Act being Act 279 of the Public Acts of 1909, as amended, and are in all respects regular;

That November 4, 1958, be set as the date for a Special Election on the question of incorporating the City of Clarencville.

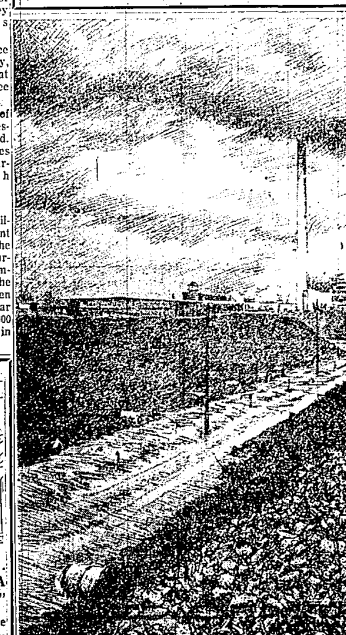

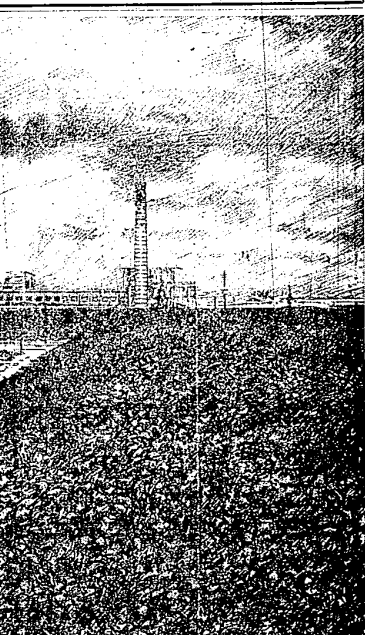
