**Takes 4 Weeks Combat Course**

Marine PVT. Denis A. Martin, son of Mr. and Mrs. P. L. Martin of 28750 Alyce Kay rd., Farmington, finished four weeks of individual combat training Dec. 4 at the Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton, California.

The course included the latest infantry tactics, first aid, demolitions, field fortifications and advanced schooling on weapons.

Trainees learn that all Marines are basically infantrymen, whether they serve as cooks, typists, truck driver, or with aviation units.

**Transfer Car Title at Once Or Pay Fine**

During the first year of enforcement, the State Department of State collected nearly a quarter of a million dollars from 46,211 people who were negligent and dilatory in transferring a vehicle title within the ten-day period required by a State law enacted a year ago.

The purchaser or transferee must present a certificate of title within 10 days after purchasing a car from another individual. Failure to do this renders the vehicle to "be deemed to be without registration." To reinstate it calls for the payment of an additional \$5.00 fee.

Secretary of State James M. Hare pointed out that this legislation was not passed to provide additional revenue but to accelerate the processing of these documents in the official files and to make them available for cooperating police and other enforcement agencies.

"Immediate transfers of such transactions also brings auto use tax money into State coffers," Hare said. "Although this extra revenue from late fees provides added income for Michigan, we prefer immediate registration and transfer of titles so that the use tax can be collected and that our records are clear and up-to-date."

This late transfer fee was first assessed on September 27, 1957. At the close of the first year, the Finance Division collected \$231,055.00 from 46,211 tardy title transfers.

**State 4th in Road Building**

Michigan was fourth in the nation in new highway construction placed under contract during September, Highway Commissioner John C. Mackie has been advised by the U. S. Bureau of Public Roads.

Mackie said the Bureau figures credited Michigan with planning some \$19.5 million in new construction under contract covering improvements for 283 miles of highways. New York led the list with \$43.1 million, followed by California with \$28.4 million, and Ohio was third with \$21.5 million in new construction awards.

Six other states, including the leading three, receive more federal highway aid than Michigan.

**Newest Map of Northern Detroit Suburbs Now Out**

Farmington is one of 34 communities charted in one of the most extensive and comprehensive maps ever made of Detroit's Northern suburbs, just published by Automobile Club of Michigan, Jerry E. Fisher, Club touring manager, announced.

The new map encompasses a 150-square mile area bounded by Eight Mile Road on the south, Draynor Road (24 Mile) on the north, and Dequindre and Halsted Roads on the east and west, respectively.

Among other cities charted are: Royal Oak, Berkley, Ferndale, Madison Heights, S. E. L. Field, Pontiac, Birmingham and Rochester. Every street in each community is drawn and in-
