Work on New National Food Moving Rapidly

Work on the rebuilding of the National Food Store in the Bel-Aire Shopping Center is moving ahead rapidly. Branch Manager P. E. Linqvist announced this week.

The original store was destroyed by a disastrous fire on February 28.

According to Linqvist, the new store will embody the latest features of modern supermarket construction. It will include the latest models of modern refrigeration equipment in all of the perishable departments — dairy, meat, frozen foods and ice cream. The entire rear wall of the store above the self-service meat department will be covered with a huge mirror reflecting the display of food products throughout the store.

Linqvist added that the new National Food Store would include the latest type Sanders self-service bakery and candy department.

The new store is being constructed by Joseph and Harold Korman of Farmington Management Company. According to Kaufman the store should be ready for occupancy within 60 days.
