Special Testing, Counseling
Being Offered by University

The University of Michigan Counseling Laboratory is offering a unique testing and counseling service to all high school students in the state of Michigan.

The personnel in the laboratory are university students who are doing graduate work in fields related to guidance training and counseling.

A student wishing educational or vocational advice or testing can make an appointment through Miss Carley or Mr. Timmons to make use of the services offered by the lab.

Each student participating in the program is first assigned a counselor who talks with him and helps him decide on the type of tests that will best solve his problems. The laboratory is equipped with rooms where the occupants cannot see out, but observers can see in. Conversations between students and counselors are taped and referred to in the future.

Test grades and conversations are not in any way related back to the high school, or to colleges where the student may be applying for admission. Only the student participating and the counselors have access to these results.

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New Reasons
To Hit Goal in
Dimes March

The National Foundation will initiate patient aid for victims of arthritis and birth defects during the current New March of Dimes campaign reaches its goal.

This announcement was made by the Rev. Dr. James H. Hodgeson, of Birmingham, Oakland County chairman of the campaign.

Mr. Hodgeson said that the national goal of the foundation is \$65,000,000. If it is met, the famed organization will begin a patient aid program for persons under 19 years of age suffering from certain types of birth defects and arthritis.

The bulk of the funds, however, will go for polio patients and the 50,000 paralysed polio victims of previous years, including those stricken in last summer's epidemics.

In Oakland County, Mr. Hodgeson said, all funds raised through the years have been needed for polio patient care and the county chapter is still helping 250 polio victims.

"In order for the Oakland County Chapter to support the national research and patient aid programs in arthritis and birth defects," Mr. Hodgeson said, "we would have to raise \$178,000 here."

"That is more money than the March of Dimes has ever raised in Oakland County but we believe it can be done if the fine people here realize the desperate need."

The chairman urged all householders to return the envelopes with their contributions and to welcome the Mothers March volunteers on Thursday evening, Jan. 28.
