

Census Takers Being Sought

W. C. Hintz, district supervisor of the 1960 Census of Population and Housing which start April 1, today issued an appeal to residents of the area to become candidates for jobs as census takers.

Applications for jobs as census takers may be made by calling FE 3-7037 or FE 3-7038 Monday through Friday.

Applications for jobs as census takers must be over 18 years of age, be citizens of the United States, and have a high school education or its equivalent. Candidates will be required to pass a selection test demonstrating their ability to understand written instructions and read maps. Persons who are presently or recently associated with law enforcement or tax assessing or collection agencies are not eligible.

Census takers will be paid on a piece price basis. A diligent census taker should earn about \$12.00 per day. The district supervisor said.
