use of the library for reference work has necessitated the recent acquisition of two more tables and additional chairs. A total of 903 books have been borrowed from Michigan State Library to fill individual requests for material not owned by our library. We are fortunate to have this service to supplement our book stock.

**THE LIBRARY** serves all ages. The books are divided into collections with special appeal for pre-schoolers, primary and elementary school age readers, young people, and adults. In addition there is an adult lounge which contains circulating magazines, sections set aside for recent books, mystery, western and short stories, reference books, and a section honoring the late Ruth Carlisle and Howard Warner.

Extra activities include talks to outside groups on request, co-sponsoring The Great Books Discussion Group with The Farmington Board of Education, School class visits to the library for book talks and orientation, and the recently added Suburban Film Service.

**THE GREAT BOOKS** Discussion Group meets every other Wednesday evening from 8:00-10:00 p.m. in the Farmington Senior High School Library. The next meeting of the group will be on February 17. The assigned reading for that date is Shakespeare's *Tempest*. New participants and visitors are cordially invited.

The Suburban Film Service was contracted for by the Farmington Friends of the Library and is now available to any group or organization (exclusive of schools). The library has the necessary identifying tickets for sale at \$2.50 per 30 minute film time. Selection of a desired film may be made from an index of films on file at the library. The library will reserve the film but it is the borrower's responsibility to pick up and return the film to the Detroit Public Library. Inasmuch as the average life of a film is only about 100 showings the borrower is honor bound to show the film but once.

**IN HONOR OF** the National February birthdays there is an interesting display of 19th century Americana this month. Part of this display was given by the library by Miss Mary Deland. The remainder is a loan from 12 year old Charlotte Ann Legg's collection of family heirlooms and features tin types of her great-great grandparents and assorted personal possessions of theirs.

New books are added to our book stock as money and time permit. Our collection is gradually growing, through purchase and gifts. The American Library Association recommends two books per person as a standard. Standards make excellent goals. At present our library owns less than 1/4 book per person. United effort and support of the library are needed to achieve our goal of a standard book collection.

## Kitchen Fires

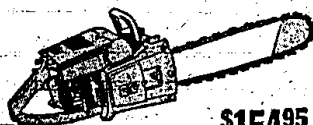
