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Advisory Committee to Study X-ray Operational Problems

LANSING—State Highway Commissioner John C. Mackie has announced that he will name a state-wide advisory committee soon to tackle the problem of motorist services on Michigan's freeways.

The study also will analyze how expressway design is changing travel habits, driver behavior, and traffic patterns.

Mackie, in a speech prepared for the Michigan Freeway Operations Seminar at Michigan State University, said no national policy on motorist services has yet been adopted by the Federal Government but that Michigan "could not wait" because its freeway program was far in advance of most states.

The speech was delivered for Mackie by Otis Hardy, Director of Motorist Services and Reports.

He pointed out that over 130 continuous miles of freeway will be open to traffic within a few months on Interstate 94 between Jackson and Stevensville, south of St. Joseph, and that the entire 225 mile route from Detroit to the Indiana line near Chicago would be open late this year or by the summer of 1961.

"Michigan will be the first state in the union to have such long stretches of freeway in operation and unlike rural roads, they don't have gas and food facilities within the right-of-way," Mackie said.

"We readily admit operational problems involving adequate directional signing to commercial services on side roads and aid for motorists stranded because of breakdowns will present problems.

He forecast one automobile breakdown for every 20,000 vehicles miles traveled based on past operating experience.

"I INTEND to name a state-wide committee with representatives of retailers, motel, tourist and resort operators, law enforcement agencies, motorists themselves and others to help make recommendations to meet these problems," he said.

Mackie said he formed a division of Motorist Services in the Highway Department last year and has made five other moves to help solve freeway operational problems.

"Construction of roadside safety rest areas every 35 miles on expressways. They average seven acres in size and will park 20 trucks and 55 cars, provide picnic facilities for 100 persons as well as toilet and telephone facilities.

"Erection of signs in advance of expressway exits in rural areas where food and lodging was available within three miles and gasoline on a 20-hour basis within one mile of the interchange.

"Providing the tourist and resort industry and chambers of commerce with a suggested
