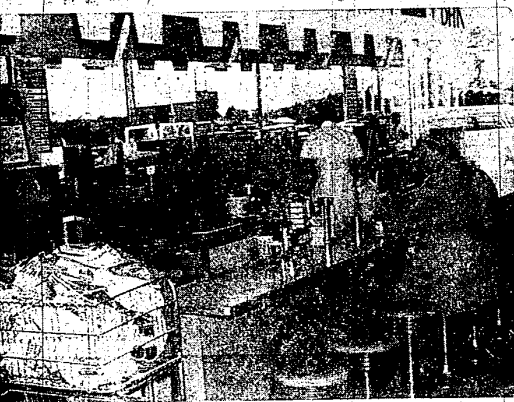
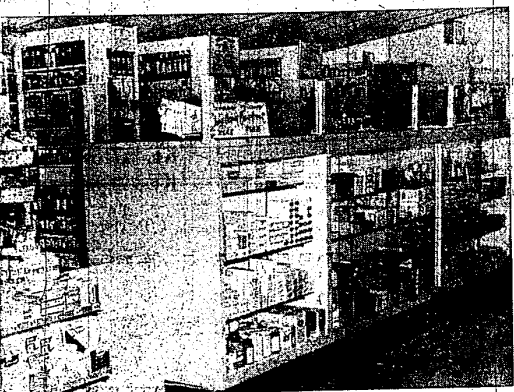


Bel-Aire Drug Doubled in Size

Add Many New Facilities at Modern Store

The recent expansion that doubled the size of Bel-Aire Drug Store is now completed adding many new facilities and expanding services to the greatest convenience of customers.

A complete jewelry department has been established at the store featuring a full line of jewelry as well as facilities for watch and jewelry repairs. In line with its general policy of competitive pricing practices, the store will offer jewelry at discount prices.

A spacious new snack bar has been incorporated in the addition to the original store. Whether the customer wants a cup of coffee or an entire meal it is available at the snack bar.

The prescription department has also undergone a facelift, and has emerged 50% larger than before, offering everyday low prices on drug needs.

IN ADDITION the cosmetic department has assumed greater proportions than before with a full line of quality cosmetics now available.

Among the other departments in the store that have also been expanded are the cigar, stationery, toy, candy and beverage departments. Beverages to suit everyone are available.
