Located five miles north of Bay City off M-47, the park fronts on Saginaw Bay, about three miles west of the mouth of the Saginaw River.

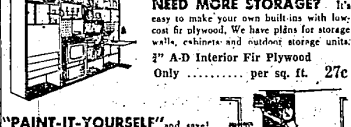
