Few Girls Participate In 'Operation Fitness'

As 'Operation Fitness' approaches the halfway mark, the number of girls participating in the program to date has been disappointing, according to officials. The track and field program was specifically designed to give both boys and girls the opportunity to take part in athletic events in preparation for the first annual Farmington Olympiad set for the last week in August.

Gene Freed, Farmington High School track coach and director of the 'Operation Fitness' program, is hoping that the girls in the area will start to take advantage of the opportunity to participate in the supervised project as physical fitness is just as important to them as it is to the boys.

After the three week preparation period, the boys and girls from 10 to 18 will begin competition in the Olympiad. Activities will range from 200 yard dashes to one mile runs as well as many field events.

Two boys, John Lomik and Bob Harris, were busy working before practice officially started when the Enterprise reporter visited the track at FHS last Friday. Freed pointed out that both these boys had set several track records at their respective junior high schools.
