Hicks Heads Elks Comm. For Handicapped Children

William Hicks has been named Chairman of the Handicapped Children Committee of B.P.O. Elks Lodge No. 1985 for the current lodge year, according to an announcement made by Elks District 1985.

Hicks' committee will handle requests for assistance for handicapped children in the Farmington-Walled Lake area who have no other avenue open for them for assistance in overcoming their handicapped condition.

Serving with Mr. Hicks on this committee are the following members: Orval Whittington and Russell Whyte.

ELKS OF MICHIGAN have a state-wide program to help any handicapped child who is ineligible for assistance from other sources. The local Elks committee will submit requests for assistance for local children to their State Major Project Committee. Efforts will be made to obtain help through other existing agencies. If it is found that none is available, Elks will give their assistance without obligation.

During the three years that this charitable program for handicapped children has been operating in Michigan, nearly 500 handicapped children have received assistance from the Elks Major Project. Aid has included medical care, dental work, equipment, therapy, and other special services. All types of handicaps are considered except brain injury, heart, and mental defects. Children are cared for by local doctors and assisted in the nearest hospitals and clinics capable of handling their problems.

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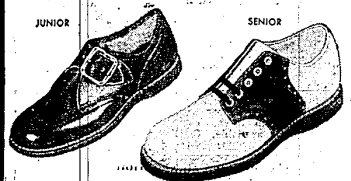
