Expect Record Crowd at Fair

The Michigan State Fair, the Nation's oldest and one of the largest, will open on the 11th anniversary of the September 11th attack on Friday, September 2, and General Manager Donald L. Swanson anticipates a record breaking attendance.

The State Fair will have a ten-day run concluding on Sunday, September 11. Last year, nearly 800,000 went through the gates, with an estimated 25,000 in the fairgrounds in 1996.

"With a break in the weather, we should have a record crowd all over the year. Interest in the State Fair is at an all-time high."

This year's State Fair actually will extend for ten days plus a night previous, Thursday, September 1, when there will be a dazzling Downtown Detroit parade along with the official opening and free Grand Michigan State Prostatection.
