AN OPEN LETTER TO THE VOTERS OF FARMINGTON TOWNSHIP

I believe that a political candidate's obligation to the voters starts not when he is elected, but as soon as he starts to campaign. He is obliged to inform the public of his views and to candidly and honestly answer questions that are asked of him. And one of the best methods to do this is by public debate.

Accordingly, I have publicly and privately offered to debate the issues and programs with my opponents and share the costs of these debates with them. The "Farmington Enterprise" editorially supported my proposal. Its February 21 editorial stated: "Men and women who want to represent the citizenry in governmental positions should be sincere enough to be willing to stand up before these same citizens and make their views known..."

My opponents have not even responded to telegrams I sent them over three weeks ago offering to debate. It appears that they are not willing to stand up before the citizens and publicly state their views. I do not know why my opponents won't publicly debate. Maybe they are afraid! There is still time. Facilities are available free. The offer still stands. My opponents need only accept it to demonstrate their sincerity and their dedication to a long-standing American tradition.
