BEAUTY BUSH
Among the shrubs that are in bloom now, the beauty bush is most outstanding. It is like a fountain of bloom, with cascading branches covered with delicate blossoms. The flowers are deep pink, but the tubular flowers are paler in tone. They are curiously formed and colored with light blue-tube flaring into two upper lobes and three slight-

ly longer lower lobes. The upper surface is pink, and the lower lobes are white, with an intricate orange network traced on the inner surface of the lower lobes. The flowers are gathered into small clusters that stud the long arching branches.

BEAUTY BUSH, which grows eight to ten feet tall, is a member of the honeysuckle family. It is a native of the high mountains of China and was first introduced to this country about 1860, making it a relatively recent introduction.
