QUILTY

At a Special meeting of the Township Board of the Township of Farmington, Oakland County, Michigan, held at the Township Hall in said Township on the 26th day of July, 1963, at 7:00 o'clock P.M., Eastern Standard Time.

PRESENT: Cairns, Bassette, Walker, Olfelt.

ABSENT: Hall, Avery, Duke.

Mr. Walker introduced Ordinance No. 30-C entitled: "An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 30-A entitled 'An Ordinance to Provide for the Establishment, Operation and Maintenance of Water Supply System' to Provide for the Acquisition of Certain Water Transmission Mains and Related Facilities as a Part of Said System; to Provide for the Issuance and Sale of Revenue Bonds to Defray a Part of the Cost of such Acquisition; to Provide for the Retirement and Security of said Bonds; to Provide for other Matters Relative to Said System and said Bonds; and to Repeal Ordinance No. 30 of the Township Ordinances."

The Ordinance was then read in full.

It was moved by Walter and seconded by Bassette that Ordinance No. 30-C be adopted. Upon roll call the vote for adoption of Ordinance No. 30-C was as follows:

Yeas, 4; Nays, 0. Carried unanimously.

The following resolution was offered by Bassette and seconded by Olfelt:

"Be it resolved by the Township Board of the Township of Farmington, Oakland County, Michigan, that the bid of Kenower, MacArthur Company, 3182251 per cent; First of Michigan, 3.45341 per cent; be accepted and that the Supervisor and Clerk be authorized to enter into contract with Coppelcia Brothers Construction Company for the construction of a 30-foot construction easement along the north line of Lot 5, Franklin Fairway Subdivision for the purpose of constructing Franklin Hills Golf Course Arm sewer line. Motion carried.

Practically all of the work on self-cement road is done by machine and as quickly as they complete their work over a given section of road traffic on the road can be resumed. Up to three miles of road can be completed in a single day.

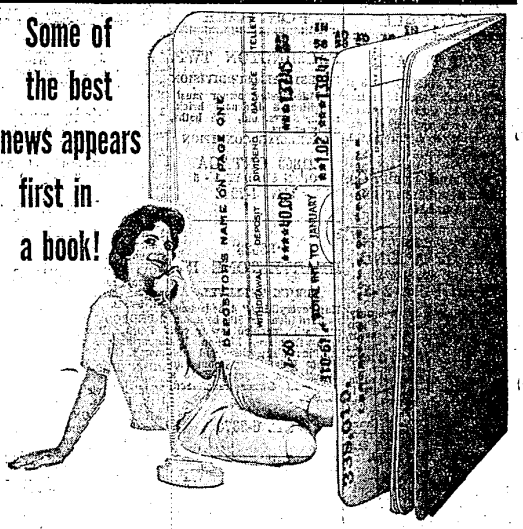
