A four-foot-high fence, of a basket weave type construction, could be drawn in an unattended pool.
Other home members point out many creeks and ponds which pose an even more dangerous threat for parents with toddlers exist in the Township and which are not being attempted to eliminate them as a drowning hazard.
THE BOARD further expressed the belief that fences required around a swimming pool are more for the purpose of keeping out teenagers who might otherwise be tempted to stage midnight pool parties. There have been two incidents where toddlers have drowned, both occurred last summer. In one instance which occurred in Quaker Run, a child drowned in a pool which is located near a stream that has a steep bank, and in the opinion of the Board, posed a more serious drowning hazard. The other drowning incident occurred in the Village of Wood Creek Farms where no fences at all are required around swimming pools.

Color Scheme Not Acceptable
Exterior and interior color schemes for the Eagle elementary school addition now under construction as suggested by the architect came in for some lengthy discussion at the regular Farmington Board of Education meeting Monday night.
The Board approved the architect's color scheme, but expressed misgivings about some of the color combinations proposed for exterior rooms. A decision on exterior colors was delayed for further consideration at a special discussion session scheduled by the Board for later in the week.

IT IS EXPECTED that the entire project will be completed by next spring with the possibility open that some of the smaller districts may have water before the whole system is completed.
Clark Floyd Cairns announced on Tuesday that the Detroit Water Board which will supply the Township with water is finalizing plans to let the bids for the construction of its portion of the project, a three-mile transmission line along Inkster Road.
The other main transmission line from the Detroit Water System is already built along Eight Mile Road. It presently serves the City of Farmington and will be tied into by the laterals to serve several of the districts in the Township's Water Supply System A.

One Part-Time Teacher to Go
Barring unexpected last minute resignations, the teaching staff for the Farmington public school system for the start of the 1963-64 school year has now been hired with the exception of one teacher needed to teach a kindergarten class for a half day.
This was the report given Tuesday by Marjorie Van Ameyde, assistant superintendent in charge of personnel.
Monday night at the regular Board of Education meeting, the hiring of five new teachers recommended by Van Ameyde was approved. The Board also approved three resignations.
