**Change in Procedure for Care of State Mentally Ill**

Care of mentally ill patients in Michigan apparently will undergo some change in procedure, but will follow the current trend under the state's new mental health chief.

Dr. Robert A. Kimmich came to Michigan from California July 1 to serve as head of the large Mental Health Department, one of his first observations was that much of the red tape involved in mental care should be eliminated. "I would like to see a minimum number of persons and places which patients has to go to in order to receive care," he said.

One trend toward part time, closed-in-home facilities, which one which should be continued, said Kimmich.

Kimmich accentuated this trend within the last three years. His aim is to provide care as close to home as possible and on a day-care or outpatient basis wherever practical.

Establishment of community care facilities was enabled by legislative act last year. Priority to this official, mental health experts touted community care centers in the answer to space demands in expanded home care facilities.

One possibility for even further localization of care for mental patients was hinted at last year. Kimmich, shortly after his arrival in the state.

He said he hoped to develop a broader program of cooperation with general medical practice, social workers and others in a position to observe potential mental problems and suggest early treatment programs.
