Richard A. Bailey, boilerman second class, USN, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert S. Fenimore of 29834 Colwell st., Farmington, was recently promoted while serving aboard the attack aircraft carrier USS Constellation operating with the Seventh Fleet in the Far East.

His promotion was based on his time in service and rate, his military appearance, performance of duties, and his passing the Navy-wide test for promotion.

Constellation, the U.S. Navy's largest conventionally powered ship, is capable of steaming at speeds of more than 35 miles per hour. Both jet and propeller driven aircraft can be launched from her four acre deck.

John S. Pingel Named Chairman Of Michigan Week Activities

John S. Pingel, president of Ross Roy, Inc., Detroit advertising agency, will be regional chairman of Michigan Week for the second year, directing all activities connected with the celebration in the Wayne-Oakland-Macomb area.

His appointment is announced by Edward L. Baker, deputy general chairman of Michigan Week, who is Detroit postmaster.

Dates of the 12th annual Michigan Week are May 16-22, but Mr. Baker called it a year-around program and emphasized that the effort to enlist eight million citizens in national and world-wide promotion of the state in connection with the 1965 celebration will begin in earnest immediately after Le-

1965 Michigan Week will be a "Dynamic in World Progress." The governor asked firms, organizations and individuals to use the theme in correspondence and many other ways.

Mr. Baker said Mr. Pingel will select his three county chairmen by the middle of September and that they will be expected to have their county Michigan Week councils in operation soon afterward.

"Michigan Week has long since ceased to be a one-week celebration," Mr. Baker said, "but rather has become a great movement bringing Michigan people together for months of special activity each year in the interest of their state.

"This year we hope to enlist thousands of citizens in the new Michigan Minute-man program in which they pledge to speak in behalf of their state when they meet people from other parts of the country."

MR. PINGEL, all American halibut at Michigan State University in 1933, is a member of the MSU Board of Trustees and is a trustee of Gross Pointe University School and of the Oakland University Foundation. He is an elder of the Grosse Pointe Memorial Presbyterian Church. Mr. and Mrs. Pingel and their two sons live in Grosse Pointe Woods.

Long active in programs to promote Michigan, Mr. Pingel is president of the Michigan agency which represents the Michigan Tourist Council. He is past president of the Aircraft Club of Detroit and was recently governor of the American Association of Advertising Agencies for the East Central states.

MR. WORK AS regional chairman of the 1964 Michigan Week was praised by both Gov. Romney and General Chairman Dale Sellers, vice president of Manufacturer National Bank of Detroit.

There are 16 Michigan Week regions, from region 1 in the western end of the Upper Peninsula to region 16 around Detroit.

The general chairman of the 1965 Michigan Week, heading a committee organization which by winter will total 10,000 people, is Woodward C. Smith, vice president of Central Michigan University at Mt. Pleasant, who has been a leader in the activity for nearly 10 years.
