He graduated in 1934 from Bentley and then earned a B. S. degree at Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti.

200 Italian Works Featured at Art Institute

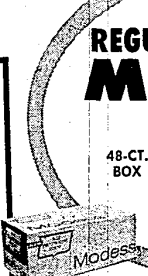
