Arbor Day Planting to Kick Off Livonia's 'Clean-Up' Campaign

An Arbor Day planting at three community sites in Livonia will kick off the community's "Clean Up, Paint Up—Fix Up—Plant Up" drive for 1985, the Keep Livonia Beautiful

Committee has announced. Trees will be planted at Carl Sandburg Library and at two Fire Stations on April 22.

The planting will be followed by a month-long city cleanup campaign starting May 1. From June 1 to 5, the annual judging of the city's cleanest subdivision will take place, and in July, a cleanup association contest will be judged on community projects will take place.

In August there will be competition among retail businesses and in September, an industry and manufacturing competition is scheduled to take place. In October an awards luncheon will honor winners of each contest and in November the committee will prepare entry notes.

Toward this end, each citizen and business is requested to cooperate by taking pictures for publication and submitting them to both the Committee (at the Mayor's office) and the Livonia Observer, or any remodeling or project undertaken either by an individual homeowner, a business or a group.
