Mrs. James Elm of Farmington, daughter of member Prosper Van Hellemont, complimented the group with a huge box of delicious homemade cookies.

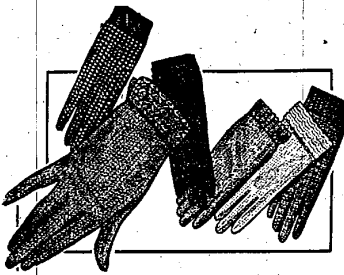

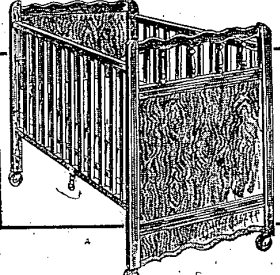

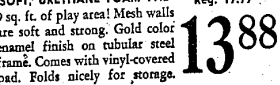
