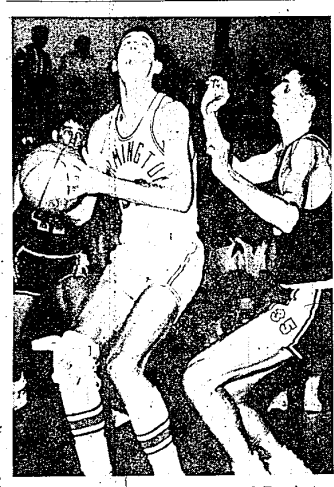


R.U. Tank Ace Sets Record in Long Race
