**Forum to Hear Talk on Civil Rights Work**

"What is the state government doing in achieving civil rights and what is its role in this field?"

The answers to these questions will be heard by those attending the monthly meeting of the businessmen's forum of the Plymouth Chamber of Commerce Thursday noon at the Hillside Inn.

Mrs. Rita Scott, director of Education for the Michigan Civil Rights Commission, will discuss "The role of state government in achieving civil rights."

Because of the critical situation of the civil rights issue at the moment in several sections of the nation, the businessmen's forum committee, headed by Dr. Ray Barber, felt it was a logical time for such a program.

Mrs. Scott is expected to tell what the State Commission on Civil Rights is doing towards the development and promotion of programs in the areas of employment, public accommodations and public schools.

Chairman Dr. Barber made arrangements for Mrs. Scott's appearance after hearing J.A. Gov. William Milliken at the Forum's March meeting.

At that time, Milliken said, "We must find in this state new jobs at the rate of 50,000 to 100,000 per year and that growth requires a new level of cooperation between labor, business, management and government — continued support of secondary and higher education and an absolute end to all forms of discrimination."

Mrs. Scott will attempt to tell what the state is doing for answer to all of the problems mentioned by Milliken.

And on the same date, there will be a hearing on rezoning for a nursing home in the Township.
