Turf, Trees Need Added Nutrients

Don't forget the shade trees when fertilizing your yard this spring. Many home owners fail to realize that little of the fertilizer applied on the lawn reaches the roots of shade trees. The turf receives most of these nutrients before they can reach the tree roots.

Use one pound of well-balanced fertilizer (10-10-10) for each one inch of trunk diameter four feet above the ground. Older trees more than six inches in diameter should get three pounds per inch of diameter. However, the amount of fertilizer should be decreased accordingly when part of the soil is covered by sidewalks.

Soak the soil thoroughly under the tree for two hours before fertilizing. Make imaginary circles surrounding the tree two feet apart until the circles extend just beyond the spread of the branches of the tree.

With a heavy bar, make holes about 24 inches apart in each of the circles. The holes should be about 18 inches deep. Using a small frozen fruit juice can, put about one-half can of fertilizer in each hole.

Keep adding fertilizer until it is used up and evenly divided. Water again and leave the holes open to allow air to penetrate down to the roots after fertilizing.

An specially designed hollow rod, which can be attached to the end of a garden hose, can be used instead of the bar for making the holes. It is pushed under the leaves and uses special fertilizer cartridges which are dissolved by the water flowing through the hose.

Home owners should let the local garden store, nursery or landscape nurseryman help in selecting the proper fertilizer. Many tree experts and landscape nurserymen also have specialized machinery to quickly complete the tree fertilization if you are not the "do-it-yourself" type.

Is a spreader really necessary for putting on lawn fertilizer? I am occasionally asked this question and the truthful answer is "No." Just as fingers were made before forks, seed and fertilizer were thrown by hand long before spreaders were invented.

However, a spreader offers many advantages. In the case of fertilizer it is likely to save you money since hand application is usually wasteful and when it comes to weed control where complete and accurate coverage is important, a spreader is practically essential.

One of the frequent complaints against spreaders is that if they are not properly cared for they are likely to run particularly at the bottom of the hopper.

To overcome this, I see that Scott's new spreaders now have a new microcrystalline bonded finish and are guaranteed to last twice as long as any spreader you may have ever owned in the past.

New Prills Give Grass Nitrogen

Feeding your lawn is like breathing. You can't store up enough this spring to last all summer. Fine lawn grasses need to be fed their nitrogen in measured amounts, slowly and continuously, to grow green and stay bright.

This presents a problem for the homeowner. He has low to gain by dumping a year's supply of fertilizer on his lawn all in one backbreaking week-end. Yet he's more likely to be cheered by the prospect of backing out his spreader every evening.

Fortunately, this dilemma is solved successfully with a product called Greenfield Measured Release Lawn Food, manufactured by Elanco Products Company, Indianapolis. This lawn food contains "prills"—little grass beads smaller than BB shots.

These beads contain nitrogen, wrapped in a porous coating which slowly lets in moisture. The moisture dissolves the enclosed nitrogen and carries it back out through the plant's roots, again—slowly and evenly over a period of weeks.

To lawn-conscious homeowners who understand why grass grows, nitrogen is the primary element that makes grass green. Each little grass plant stores the nitrogen it needs in its leaf blades. Each time the grass is mowed—CLIP—part of this stored nitrogen falls away, right when the grass plant needs nitrogen most for new top growth.

A properly fed lawn, receiving a steady supply of nitrogen from prills, stays green through many mowings.

Feeding by prill offers other advantages. There is no wild burst of growth at application time and no burned spots from localized over-fertilization. It's economical, too, since it saves and puts to work a lot of nitrogen which might otherwise leach wastefully away at the first rain.
