All musicians in and around Farmington are invited to join the Farmington Community Summer Evening Serenade Band for its eleventh season.

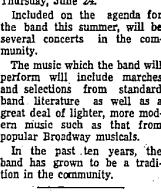
The group will rehearse in the band room of the Farmington Senior High School every Monday and Thursday evening from 7:15 to 9 p.m., beginning Thursday, June 24.
