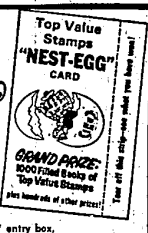

Wolverine To Show State's Best

Moving into the final week-end of the most successful harness racing meeting in Michigan history, Wolverine Raceway will present the state's fastest and best two and three-year-old pacers in the Spring Championships on Friday and Saturday (June 18 and 19).

Wolverine operates at the Detroit Race Course, Middlebelt and Schoolcraft Roads, in the Northwest Detroit suburb of Livonia.

Wolverine's nightly handle is at an all-time record high of \$433,340 and attendance is up 7.3 percent with an average of 6,889, the best in history. Friday's \$2,500 Colt Stake for two-year-old pacing colts and geldings is headed by the Big Bear, who became the first Michigan-bred to win the Great State in 93 years. The colt is owned by Jack Stahl of Detroit.

But the biggest race of all comes on Saturday when a field, considered the best in years, clashes in the three-year-old championship pace. The starters will include Peppy Reico, generally rated as king of the hill.

Then with the 55-night meeting out of the way, the pacers and trotters will move to Northville Downs on Monday (June 21) for the start of a 59-night meeting, ending on Wednesday, August 4.
