Missionary Association Sets Meeting

The Michigan-Canadian Area of the Church of Jesus Christ's Missionary Association will hold its annual conference at one of the Faiths east side churches, 16241 Harper, July 17, 1965. Sessions are scheduled for 2 p.m. and 7 p.m.

Election of officers and planning for future activities will highlight the meetings. In the evening session, the Area Choir will sing various selections.

The Missionary Benevolent Association is composed of local, regional, and general levels. The local level is made up of M. B. A. groups from within the branches of the church, and the regional units, called "M. B. A. Areas," are composed of the local groups from within their regional geographical boundaries.

The general level serves as the head of the organization and is directly auxiliary to the General Church, whose main branch is in Monongahela, Pennsylvania. There are four main purposes for the M. B. A. They are the conducting of scriptural study classes, the granting of missionary assistance, the setting out and giving of aid to needy persons, and the spiritual guidance for young people.

Record Crowds Tour Ford's Rouge Plant

More than 82,000 men, women and children—some from as far as Tanzania, Africa—toured Ford Motor Company's famous Rouge manufacturing complex during the first six months of 1965.

The Rouge contains the largest production foundry in America, the nation's longest privately owned railroad, a basic oxygen steel-making facility and a Mustang assembly plant, as well as engine, tool and die, stamping and other manufacturing operations.

Two-hour Rouge tours leave every half-hour, 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday, except holidays, from Ford's headquarters building on Michigan Avenue near the Southfield Freeway in Dearborn.
