

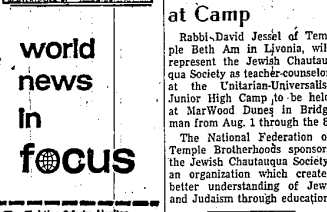
Rev. Elvin Clark Named Pastor

Mother Laudine Elected Felician Vicar General

Mother Mary Laudine, C.S.S.F., provincial superior of the Felician Sisters Motherhouse in Livonia, and the founding principal of Ladywood High School has been elected Vicar General of the Felician Congregation.

The congregation claims a membership of more than 5,000 nuns stationed on three continents.

In the area the Felician Sisters conduct Madonna College, St. Mary Hospital, Ladywood High School, and staff a score of elementary parish schools.

Mother Laudine's term as provincial superior expires in Dec. 1966. At that time she will establish a six year residence at the Congregation's Generalate in Rome.

Originally from Detroit, Mother Laudine attended St. Casimir elementary school and the Felician Academy. She received her A.B. degree from Siena Heights College in Adrian and her M.A. from the University of Notre Dame.

Mother taught in several high schools before she was appointed first principal of Ladywood High School, Livonia, in 1950. Under her direction, the girls' school merited accreditation by the

University of Michigan and doubled its original enrollment.

In 1955, Mother Laudine assumed a position on the provincial council. In this capacity she served at spiritual counsel to the younger members of the congregation.

Her next community appointment came in 1959 when she was elected provincial superior.

During her administration, Mother Laudine's most direct concern was the spiritual well-being of the 800 sisters of the province. Mother's sphere of influence extended to some 50 parish elementary and high schools, three Central High schools, two private high schools, Angelus Hall for girls,

and St. Joseph Home for boys.

An intense development program also flourished under Mother's initiative. This included the completion and renovation of the convent chapel, the erection of the residence and academic buildings of Madonna College, the addition of a new wing to the convent for the aged and infirm sisters, the expansion of Ladywood High School and St. Mary's Hospital. Besides the construction of the new emergency department in the hospital proper, a convent was erected for the sister nurses.
