

Michigan Road Toll Takes Dip

Michigan's 188 traffic deaths in July were 32 or 15 per cent less than 218 in the same month a year ago, according to State Police provisional figures.

July was the fifth of seven months so far in 1965 with a decrease compared with the corresponding months last year. There were increases in April and June.

The July deaths bring the provisional seven-month toll to 1,060 which is 121 or 10 per cent lower than 1,181 in the same period in 1964.
