#### Delta Gamma Auction Mon.

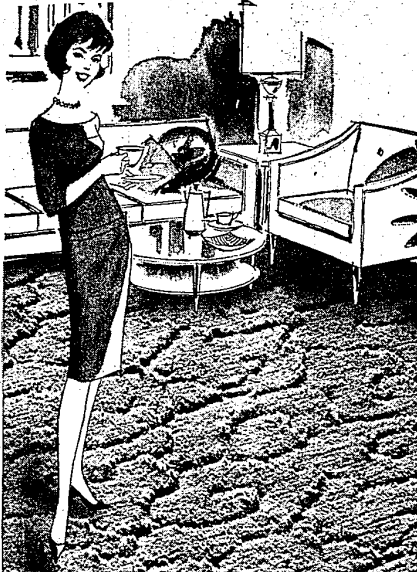

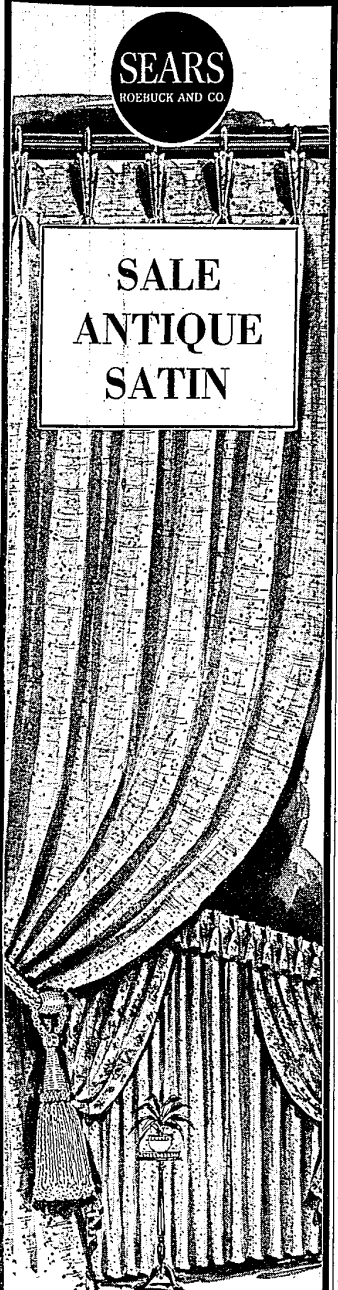

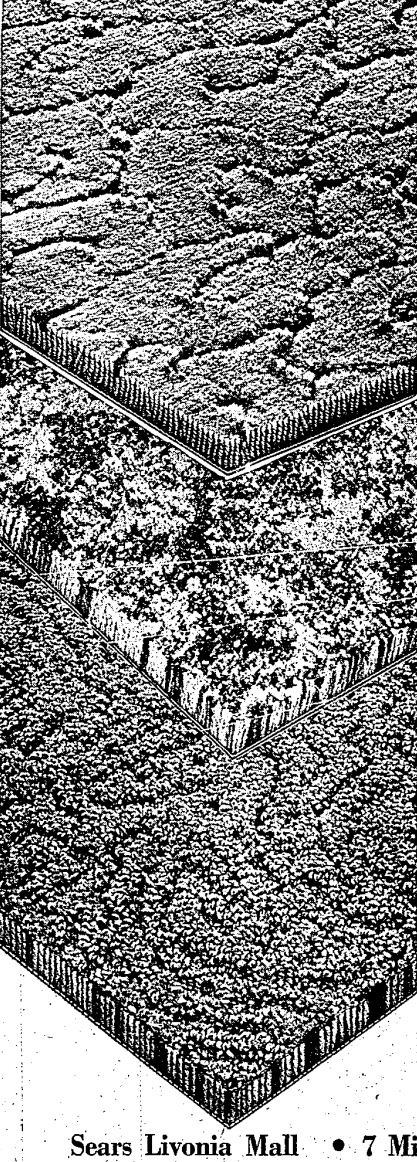
